Christians believe that Jesus came to Earth to get people into heaven but also to make the world more like heaven. Jesus told parables about the 'kingdom of God' or the 'kingdom of heaven' to explain this idea.

The Feast: Luke 14:12-24

A man was having a great banquet and invited many guests. They made excuses

About why they couldn't go.



Then the owner of the house became angry and ordered his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and bring in the poor, the crippled, the blind and the lame.' There was still more room and so the servants were sent out to fill the room. He said, 'I tell you, not one of those who were invited will get a taste of my banquet.'

Jesus was telling his followers how he wanted them to behave. He wanted the kingdom of heaven to be open for everyone. People should not be so busy and distracted that they forget to worship God. The kingdom of God is compared to a feast where all are invited to join in. but not everyone chooses to do so.

In Luke 4:1-8 Jesus was tempted in the wilderness by the devil. Jesus refuses the devil's offer to rule the kingdom and be the king of all nations on Earth. This tells us that Jesus

Martin Luther King was famous for his nonviolent resistance to achieve equal rights for Black Americans earned him the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 .

Malala Yousafzai became an international symbol of the fight for girls' education after she was shot in 2012 for opposing Taliban restrictions on female education. She is the world's youngest person to receive Nobel Peace Prize - at just 17.
