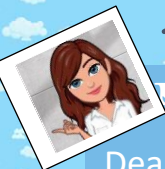

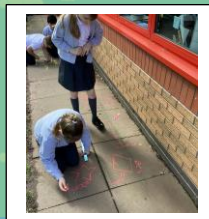

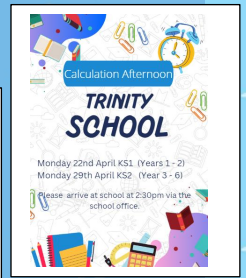


Year 5 have been enjoying some time in the sunshine creating their own regular polygons. The children discussed how each side of a regular polygon is equivalent in length and came up with the formula 'length x number of sides' to calculate the perimeter of the shape.



NEWS AND UPDATES:

Year 2 have loved their practical learning in maths. They have been learning all about different units of measurement, including temperature, length and volume. The children have been working together, linking to our HEART value of Team Trinity. We hope to see our Year 1 and 2 parents on Monday 22nd April for our calculation afternoon!



Year 3 started a new text in English this week, 'The Secret of Black Rock'. One of the lessons this week saw the children re-enacting the moment our main character falls from a boat into the water. First, they explored other texts and media that saw characters in similar situations then they worked in small groups to create freeze-frames for the moment before, during and after he character falls. They had to consider facial expression as well as hand and body positions. The children were then asked, one at a time, to unfreeze and provide the characters inner thoughts at that moment.
