Jesus is also known as the ‘fisher of men’. This is how he called the first disciples,. Most Christians might identify with one of the fishermen — attracted by the good news, feeling under-qualified, perhaps.

<b>Christian</b> 	A person who believes in God, Christ and his teachings.
<b>Gospel</b> 	These are four biblical stories about the life and death of Jesus. They were written by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
<b>Disciple</b> 	A follower of Jesus during his life.
<b>Old Testament</b> 	The first part of the Christian bible.
<b>New Testament</b> 	The second part of the Christian bible. It discusses Jesus and his teachings.
