

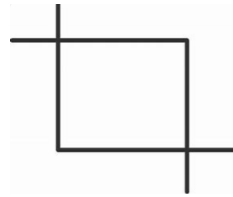


Overview

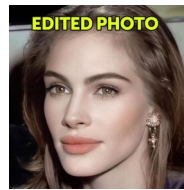
Cropping an image to change the size.

Images on the internet may belong to different people or companies—the person who wrote it or the company who published it. The content may be copyrighted, meaning that others cannot copy or use it without permission.

Not all of the images that we see or hear on the internet are reliable. Many images have been retouched or edited.



We must be careful when we share images, especially of ourselves or others. We must think before we post or send!
