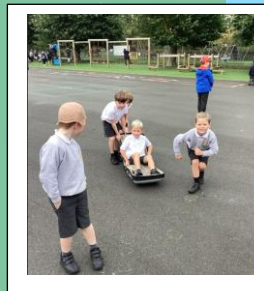
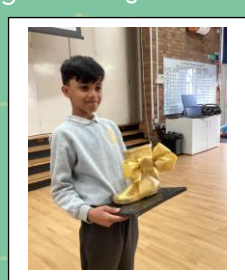
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## NEWS AND UPDATES: OPAL

We have also enjoyed some fantastic digging adventures on the field - please do remember to supply wellies for your child if they would like to play on the field at lunchtimes.

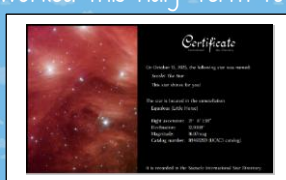
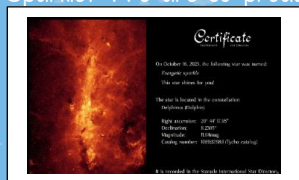


## NEWS AND UPDATES:
