What a wonderfully busy and enriching week it has been in school. Classrooms have been full of curiosity, enthusiasm, and plenty of our HEART values on display.

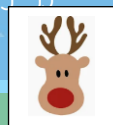
Year 1 Ecologist Visit

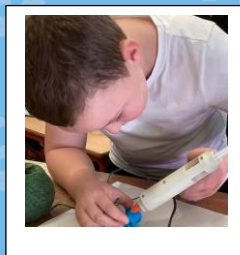
NEWS AND UPDATES: CHRISTMAS TREE
