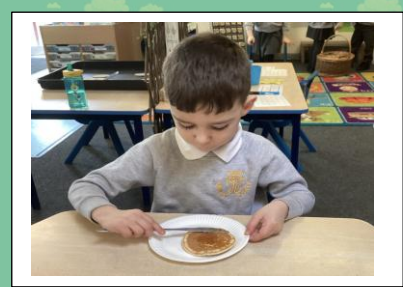

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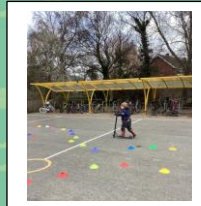
NEWS AND UPDATES: OPAL

Scooters continue to be a firm favourite and we always need more - if you are having a clear out, please do bring any unused scooters into school and we will put them to good use.

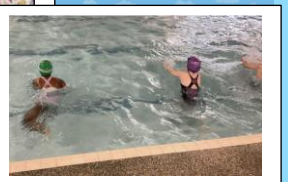
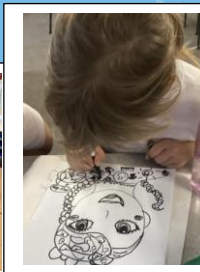
Our golden wellies this week went to two members of Year 3 who have been fantastic HEART helpers in the mud area.
