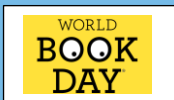

Dear Parents and Carers,

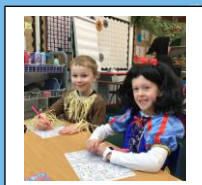


What a wonderfully busy and inspiring week it has been in school as we have celebrated books and the joy of reading together.
