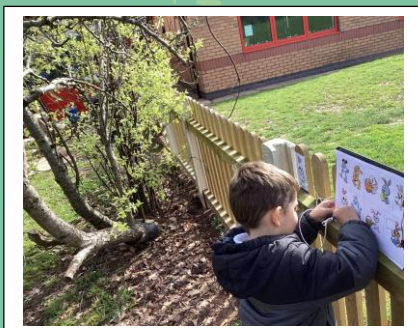

Bike and Junior parkrun fun! Sunday 26.04.26

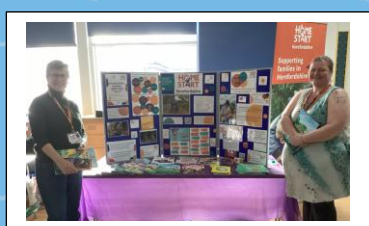
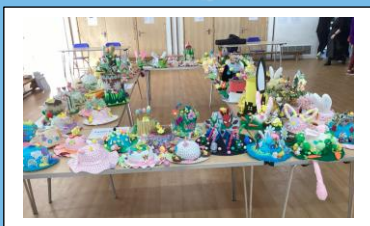
