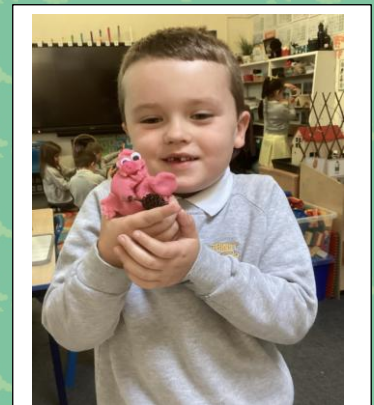

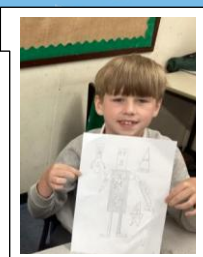
Thanks again for your ongoing support, donations and belief as we move forward with the project to make the most of the power of play at Trinity.
